

## **Bechtel SAIC Company, LLC (BSC)**

Each BSC employee has an assigned location code that will follow him/her through the systems used by the HR, the Chief Financial Officer (CFO), and the Project Control (PC) offices. BSC has two overhead (indirect) cost pools: the General & Administrative (G&A) expense pool costs are applied to total costs incurred for all work; and the Location Specific pool costs are applied to the labor performed at on-site locations. The burdening for the Location Specific pool costs is based on an approach described as the “home-office approach”. In effect, the burdening is based on where the employee is assigned in the system, rather than where the work is that they performed.

When the duration of a work assignment exceeds 60 days (but not more than one year) and the temporary duty (TDY) location is more than 75 miles from either the permanent location or place of residence, the employee’s assignment will be considered temporary duty. At this time, the employee’s assigned location code in the system should be changed, causing a change to the manner in which the employee’s costs are burdened. A TDY location is defined a place away from an employee’s official station, where the employee is authorized to travel.
